ACADEMIC ROADMAP Combined Criminal Justice BS/MS 5½-Year Plan

The roadmap provides a plan for completing your major and general education coursework within 5½ years. All academic requirements outlined in the Undergraduate Catalog must be met to successfully complete the degree. The combined program has 30 credits in the undergraduate criminal justice major, 33-39 credits of Intellectual Foundation requirements, 39-45 credits of all college electives and 36 credits of graduate coursework for a total of 144 credit hours. Twelve credits of graduate coursework may be applied to both the undergraduate and graduate degrees. Through the combined program, students can save a semester of tuition dollars.

Students complete most of their undergraduate requirements in the first three years. Students begin graduate coursework, at undergraduate tuition rates, in their senior year of study; these courses apply to both the undergraduate and graduate degree requirements. Students registering for a concentration in the major (other than the integrated concentration) must complete the concentration in their senior year by taking the appropriate criminal justice courses in lieu of all college electives. Upon completing all undergraduate degree requirements and maintaining a minimum cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0 and a minimum 3.0 GPA in each graduate course, students matriculate directly into the Master's in Criminal Justice degree program. Twelve graduate credits will be applied to the graduate course of study, and all graduate policies and privileges will be in effect. Candidates then continue with the remainder of their graduate study to fulfill the requirements for their Master's degree. Graduate School application fees are waived for students in the combined program.

Students must complete all 30 credits of undergraduate criminal justice coursework listed below along with 89 completed credits overall and have a GPA of 3.2 or above in the major and overall. The deadline for applications to program is July 1; notice of acceptance into the program will be provided by July 15.
